

The Porsche Sprint Challenge Benelux.

Motorsport is a time consuming passion and many racing drivers face a challenge to combine their passion with business and family life. With the new concept of the Porsche Sprint Challenge Benelux a new solution to this trade-off is provided. With one-day events that take place during the work week, racing in a time efficient way and at 100% Porsche branded events is now possible. All while keeping the weekend free for family matters.

The new concept features a free practice of one hour, a qualifying of 30 minutes and two races of 30 minutes each, all on one day. The combined track time of 150 minutes is paired with a Porsche Hospitality that ensures an exclusive environment to relax and network between sessions. A formula that positions the Porsche Sprint Challenge Benelux as the go to series for an action packed, yet exclusive and relaxing, day at the track without long travel or long waiting between sessions.

Four of the five events are joint events with the Porsche Track **Experience** and track days organized by PON Porsche Import and GP Elite. Together both programmes create a special atmosphere for all participants: A small Porsche festival at the race track and a joint Porsche hospitality that enables drivers and teams to network with like minded Porsche enthusiasts.

The series is focussed on racing drivers making the transition from track days to racing and **gentlemen drivers**. To ensure an equal level of experience and speed, drivers of the "pro" classification of a Porsche Carrera Cup or Porsche Mobil1 Supercup are not permitted in this championship. Furthermore, to emphasize the position of the series in the base of the Porsche Motorsport Pyramid, all races will feature a rolling start.




Porsche Motorsport Pyramid Benelux.

The Porsche Motorsport Pyramid Benelux now offers even more opportunities for aspiring racing drivers.

Starting with Porsche Experience Track Days, the pyramid moves up through the Porsche Sprint Challenge Benelux, Porsche Endurance Trophy Benelux, Porsche Carrera Cup Benelux and Porsche Mobil Supercup.

The Benelux pyramid sees Gentlemen drivers and young talented pro drivers alike move through the Porsche one-make series. Within the Porsche Motorsport Pyramid drivers further develop their skills and race craft over time and make continuous steps towards the top of Porsche Customer Racing in the Benelux and beyond.





Event schedule.

The official event schedule of the Porsche Sprint Challenge Benelux is developed for gentlemen drivers with limited time. **One-day events** with maximum race action and a Porsche hospitality to relax in between the track action is the formula for the new concept.

All events take place on days during the workweek. Teams will be situated in the **pit garages to minimize logistic efforts** and crew necessity.

In general, the following event schedule is aimed for:

Porsche Experience.

The Porsche Sprint Challenge Benelux events are pure Porsche Events. Alongside the Porsche Sprint Challenge Benelux, the **Porsche Track Experience and track days** organized by PON Porsche Import and GP Elite are held during the four events in the Netherlands. Both track day concepts are aimed for experienced track day customers and offer the possibility to **invite sponsors and guests** to the racetrack.

The joint event is **100% Porsche branded** and with both event programmes combined an exclusive atmosphere at the racetrack is created. Adding to the atmosphere, the joint Porsche hospitality is the ideal place to relax between track sessions and meet with fellow Porsche enthusiasts.





Tracks.

The Porsche Sprint Challenge Benelux 2022 calendar offers races on three renown tracks of the Benelux. Racing close to home and one day events during the workweek make it possible to enjoy Porsche racing with limited time away from home.

Entry.

The 'PSCB Entry Form' is the starting point for participation in the Porsche Sprint Challenge Benelux. The competitor and driver are eligible to participate as soon as the 'PSCB Entry Form' has been confirmed by the series organisation and the entry fee has been paid. An entry is valid for the entire season, which means that a competitor is obliged to participate at all classification rounds.

Included in the entry fee for the 2022 Porsche Sprint Challenge Benelux is the participation for one car with one or two driver(s) for all 5 race events. Additionally, one hospitality package is included. Further packages are available if needed.

With the series focussing on gentlemen and prior track day drivers, drivers who participated in a Porsche Carrera Cup or Porsche Mobil1 Supercup in the "pro" classification are not permitted in this championship.

Guest entries are possible during each event of the Porsche Sprint Challenge Benelux. However, full season entries have priority over guest entries in case there is a limited number of eligible participants at an event. Guest drivers also score points, participate in podium ceremonies and in the championship classification.

Entry conditions.

To apply with the 'PSCB Entry form', the following documents need to be submitted to the series organisation:

- Fully completed 'PSCB Entry From'
- Payment of the entry fee
- Copy of a valid KNAF EU / National license or license issued by an ASN from another EU country
- Medical certificate of aptitude for the driver

Divisions.

The Porsche Sprint Challenge Benelux is separated in different divisions and allows participation with Porsche GT3 Cup and GT4 cars from past generations. With a separated classification each of the three divisions crowns its own Porsche Sprint Challenge Benelux champion at the end of the year.

Within divisions a balance of performance, developed in cooperation with Porsche AG, is applied to achieve fair and close racing within larger groups of cars. ABS is permitted in all divisions.

Team Catering.

The Porsche Team Catering is available at all events of the Porsche Sprint Challenge Benelux. Within the Porsche Hospitality breakfast, lunch and dinner are offered in buffet form. The teams and drivers can choose the food to their liking. Drinks are in constant supply, and a selection of cakes and snacks are available in the afternoon.

The service times are scheduled according to the respective event schedule and announced via the team information and on the information board in the hospitality. With each entered car, the driver receives one catering package included in the entry fee. Additional catering packages can be ordered up to one week before the event.

Porsche Technical Support.

Our engineering and technical staff are happy to assist you with any questions you may have about your Porsche race car and additional technology (data recording, etc.) of Porsche AG at our workspace and at the circuits. If you have any further questions regarding any technical or logistical issues, please contact the series organisation.

Spare Parts Service.

The Prospeed Competition truck travels to each round of the Porsche Sprint Challenge Benelux and provides an extensive spare part service for all running race cars. The parts manager on location provides a professional service to all teams in order to ensure a quick return to the track after an incident.

Tyre Service.

Michelin is the official tyre partner of the Porsche Sprint Challenge Benelux. Michelin has developed a tyre exclusively for the Porsche one-make series. These tyres can only be obtained by entered teams. Michelin's tyre service is available at every race event, providing comprehensive customer service.
